

Dear Florida High School Swim Coach,

The Florida Swimming Pool Association (FSPA) is proud to announce the **48th Annual Florida Swims High School Swim Meet**, benefiting the Swimming Pool Education & Safety Foundation. We invite your school to participate in this statewide event, which draws more than 50 teams and nearly 1,000 competitors. We are excited to host this year's meet at the state-of-the-art **Florida Aquatics Swimming and Training (FAST)** facility located in Ocala, FL.

Important Meet & Facility Information:

- This is an air-conditioned indoor pool facility with a dedicated locker room for athletes on the first floor ([see facility map](#)).
- **Parking is free.** Parking staff will be available in the main lot to direct your vehicles. Buses will park in the back lot.
- **Coaches are responsible for picking up all wristbands** at the main entrance and distributing them to athletes before they enter the pool deck.
- Teams are not permitted on the pool deck unless they are competing that day, and the pool has officially opened for controlled warm-ups.
- **The deck has seating for 800 athletes.** Please advise your team not to bring chairs, tents, etc., as bleacher seating will be available.
- **This meet will have a closed deck.** Spectators and parents will have seating with seatbacks on the second floor. *Dedicated ADA seating is also available.*
- Entry deadline: **Friday, September 25, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.**
- Due to anticipated high attendance, there will be a team cap. **Please [RSVP here](#) to secure your spot.** **Higher ranking will be given to schools who have previously attended*

This meet includes an optional **Developmental Program** designed for novice and developing swimmers who do not meet the qualifying standards for the Invitational Meet.

Coaches are strongly encouraged to enter swimmers in the Invitational Meet whenever they have achieved the qualifying standards. The Developmental Program is intended to provide a positive competitive experience for newer athletes. **It does not offer awards, and official times will not be recorded for ranking or qualification purposes.**

SWIMMING PROGRAM:

1. The warm-up schedule will be e-mailed to coaches the week of the event and posted to www.FSPASwimMeet.com
2. Timed Finals format run in a 10-lane competition pool
3. No qualifying times for the Developmental Competition
4. No Diving in Developmental Competition
5. Individual competitors are permitted to enter a maximum of 4 events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events.
6. If an individual swims in the Developmental Competition, he/she may only enter relays for the FSPA Invite.
7. Flyover starts may be used and heats may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee
8. **Each school is allowed one (1) team in each relay event**

- No qualifying times for relays
- The preliminary session will be conducted in one or two pools depending on entries and at the discretion of meet management. Flyover starts may be utilized.
- Finals will be conducted in one 10 lane pool
- Individual competitors are permitted to enter a maximum of 4 events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events. Preliminaries and finals are considered one meet.
- Each school is allowed four (4) individuals in each event
- **Each school is allowed one (1) team in each relay event**
- If an individual swims in the Developmental Competition, he/she may only enter relays for the Invite. The athlete's name must appear in the FSPA High School Invitational Meet database to allow for eligibility. Athletes swimming and not appearing in the database will not be considered eligible and will disqualify the relay for use of an ineligible athlete.
- Alternates wishing to compete in the Consolation Final must be in starter's area and ready to swim when called
- Scratches for finals are to be reported to Administration prior to the end of the preliminary session
- There will be 2 heats in finals, a consolation final (B) to be followed by the championship final (A)
